We are delighted that you're here and hope that you enjoy the afternoon's music. We are just two



# PODIUM NOTES

Thank you for joining us as we move into the season of Spring, which often reflects a time of renewal and freshness, providing hope even if the world seems like an unsure place. The dreariness of winter fades as gardens begin to bloom, the breeze of the lake is warmed with sunlight, and blue skies take over the gray blanket that stretched above us since the fall. With spring being so much a time of renewal and celebrating life, why perform a requiem?

Fauré's *Requiem* is different. It isn't a dramatic setting of "Dies Irae," the Day of Wrath or Judgment we find as a focal point in other composers' requiems. Fauré hardly refers to the idea. He is focused more on the freeing of the spirit, the release of one's hardships to explore and examine one's faith, and the gift of eternal rest. We don't know Fauré's original intent for writing the *Requiem*, albeit speculation surrounds the passing of his parents. But unlike most major works, this was with no commission and written and rewritten over a span of 15 years (1887-1902) creating many different published versions. So many, that often in the music world when we discuss Faure's *Requiem*, we need to clarify which dated version? (We are doing the 1893 version for those curious.)

Originally called a *Petit Requiem* in 1887, Fauré's original version was scored for a choir, solo violin and chamber orchestra of violas, cellos and basses, harp, timpani and organ. Only writing with the lower strings emphasizes the tender consoling landscape of the piece. In his 1893, he made several additions with the *Offertoire* and *Libera me*, which originally were compositions form his other projects, and added the bassoons, horns and trumpets. Later versions published asked him to create arrangements for full orchestra. But, in the latter half of the 20th Century, scholars such as composer John Rutter worked to reconstruct Fauré's original 1893 orchestration to be the closest to Fauré's original intent.

While many may not think of Fauré's *Requiem* with household notoriety as a Mozart or Verdi requiem, his beautiful themes from several of the movements like *Sanctus, Agnus Dei, Paradisum*, and the crystal melody of the soprano solo's *Pie Jesu* have been used in cinema, stand-alone concert pieces, and church music for over a century. It is with this compositional intention and beauty that Fauré's *Requiem* has been called "a lullaby of death." As he said he sees it "as a happy deliverance, an aspiration towards happiness above, rather than as a painful experience."

While Faure's Requiem is a musical mass in remembrance of the dead, like our performance last year of Dan Forrest's *Requiem for the Living*, this piece is really written to comfort those of us left behind hearing the work, providing us the opportunity to listen, reflect, remember, and let go of our inner most turmoil, if even for just a few moments, to the healing power and peace found in the magic of the music.

# MICHAEL SHIRTZ



Michael Shirtz is a performer, educator, composer, and conductor, known for his versatility with jazz, contemporary, and classical music. Credited as a "songsmith," his vocals and arrangements feature jazz and singer-songwriter styles into his performances as both a solo artist and with his group, the Michael Shirtz Quartet. He has worked with such artists as Melissa Manchester, Evelyn Wright, and as music director for Maureen McGovern, among others. As an artist Shirtz is

affiliated with the Prima Music Foundation and the Musical Theatre Project. His shows include tributes to legendary artists in "As We've Learned It," "In Finding Faith," and his "Blue Skies" show and album released in 2018.

With a passion for fostering creativity and collaboration, Shirtz has emerged as a respected figure in both the jazz and choral communities as a conductor and educator. Shirtz has directed educational, theatre, masterworks, and pops music productions for choral, symphonic, and festival organizations. As a producer he has served with Tri-C JazzFest Cleveland, Jazz@8 Series, Jazz Education Network, and jazz in schools initiative. Shirtz is a music director for Lakeside Chautauqua and conductor of the Symphony Chorale with the Firelands Symphony Orchestra. He has written compositions for jazz, choir, theater, and extended works such as the cantata *The Solemn Blessings*, the musical *Headliner*, and *To Rise Above: A Journey of a Tuskegee Airman*.

Shirtz currently serves on faculty with The Ohio State University School of Music where he teaches applied voice, studio, and jazz voice. He has served on the faculties of Capital University, Heidelberg University, director-in-residence at Pellissippi State-Knoxville, and Terra State Community College where he held the positions of lead faculty and dean. Shirtz is a member of ASCAP, American Choral Directors Association, African American Jazz Caucus, and the National Association of Teachers of Singing. Shirtz received a Bachelor of Music in Jazz Studies from Capital University and Master of Music in Conducting from California State University, Los Angeles.
